

Week 8 - Session 2 - Fish Unit

Goals

Today your child will be focusing on learning the parts of a fish. Children are invited to watch the fish puzzle demonstration, and parents can print out the "fish" nomenclature cards to support your child's writing and reading skills. The book is best known for its morals about the value of being an individual and for the distinctive shiny foil scales of the Rainbow Fish. During the next morning session, the teacher will ask the children to share their thoughts on the story!
